

Covered Bridge Challenge Game Rules

Covered bridges are a unique feature of Vermont's landscape. In fact, Vermont boasts the greatest concentration of covered bridges in the U.S. with 106 covered bridges throughout the state. Take the Covered Bridge Challenge and visit these historical monuments on your motorcycle rides and enter to win prizes.

Game Rules:

1. Contest starts March 1st thru December 2009
2. Entry Fee: \$15.00 per bike
3. Entry includes bridge lapel pin and covered bridge map (get additional maps at the Burlington's Chamber of Commerce, 60 Main St. Burlington, VT)
4. All who visit 106 bridges will get a special "Bridge Challenge" patch
5. Visit 106 bridges and you are eligible to win the Grand Prize drawing. **Grand Prize drawing is a set of stock tires, mounted & balanced.**
6. Must provide proof of each bridge visited. Take a picture of your bike with the bridge (ideally you & bike) Also take a picture of the bridge # to identify the bridge (if applicable)
7. Bring your picture into GMHD for verification. You can bring in printed photos or show us the pictures on your camera.
(You could probably get away with using Photoshop but that would be cheating and that would be wrong)
8. Receive a prize drawing ticket for each bridge verification (one ticket per bike). Place a pin marker on the covered bridge map at GMHD
9. Prizes awarded at the Champlain Valley H.O.G. holiday party in January or February 2010 (Need not be present to win grand prize)
10. All tickets will be entered into the Champlain Valley H.O.G. holiday party drawings. We anticipate \$25/50/75 prize drawings along with other prizes donated from local businesses. 11. Those who visit all 106 bridges will also be entered into the Grand Prize drawing for the motorcycle tires. There will only be one Grand Prize winner.
